Review of Financials - Fales

- Update on financials as presented. There is \$86,000 among the three accounts.
- No transactions other than the trip expenses such as Hiratsuka gifts
- There were some membership dues
- The trip accounting for Eutin is in process
- Arne Scholz wants to wait until the Eutin trip to Lawrence is complete before a final reconciliation
- One Eutin student has not paid the trip balance yet; Scholz will check on it.
- A \$200 refund was issued for a duplicate payment.
- Total trip fees were \$1700 for Eutin
- We are \$150 from our membership goal
- Scholz moved and Albrecht seconded. Report was accepted.

- Fales is compiling a newsletter with reports on the two trips and will send to the members with new bylaws for the Website
- We need to get volunteers for committees from the parents and members
- Membership and media committees should meet before the August meeting

FoH (Friends of Hiratsuka)--Johnson

- Johnson reported on the Hiratsuka trip
- Culture day was a major success
- There were a few bumps because of cell phone use; need to have a clear policy that students and parents sign in advance.
- Need a more specific policy discussion during Saturday school
- There is a debriefing meeting on July 15 and the phone policy will be discussed; it needs to be
 discussed prior to the Hiratsuka students visiting Lawrence. Scholz suggested that the first step be a
 policy for the return visit that phones be on airplane mode which is checked and if the plane is used for
 anything other than that, then the phone is taken.
